March Raffle profit was \$2130.

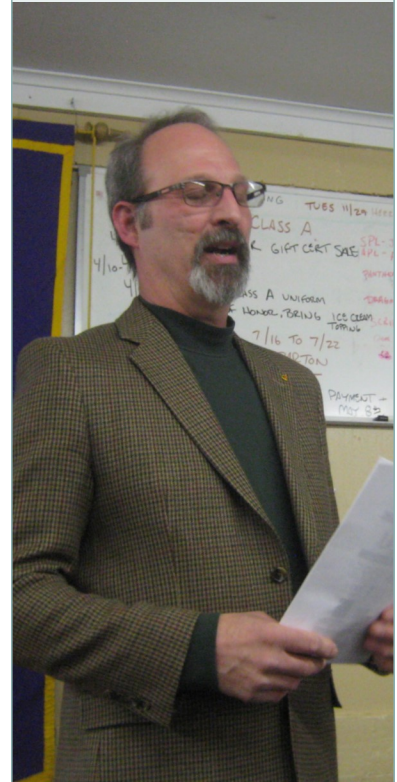
