Dues are \$70. Please pay them asap. The check should be made out to Barker Lions and mailed to Lion Jim at 7171 Lake Rd, Appleton.

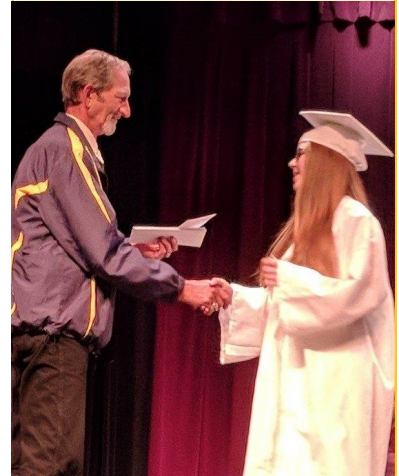
We were in the Somerset Town Newsletter.
