Lion Past President Jim Bittner is the new Niagara County Farm Bureau President. Vice President for that board is Lion Past President Kevin Bittner.

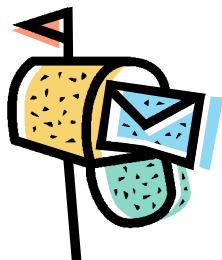
Cheese Sale
